

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TICKET SALES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 481B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§481B- No ticket broker shall charge a fee for the use
5 of a credit card to purchase tickets without first disclosing
6 that a fee will be charged.

7 For the purposes of this section "ticket broker" means any
8 person engaged in the business of selling tickets of admission
9 or any other evidence of right of entry to a theater, place of
10 amusement or entertainment, or other place where public
11 exhibitions, games, contests, or performances are held, at a
12 price greater than the price printed on the ticket."

13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
