
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GASOLINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that gasoline that meets
2 the ethanol content requirement set forth in section 486J-10,
3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, is damaging to the non-metal parts of
4 the fuel storage and engine systems in marine engines and other
5 small gasoline-driven tools.

6 The purpose of this Act is to require refiners to make
7 available gasoline that does not contain ethanol for marine
8 equipment and small tool users.

9 SECTION 2. Chapter 486H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
11 and to read as follows:

12 "§486H- **Provision of gasoline not containing ethanol.**
13 Each refiner, as that term is defined in section 486J-1, shall
14 make available to marine fueling stations and its company-
15 operated stations that are owned and operated by the refiner
16 gasoline that does not contain the ethanol content required by
17 section 486J-10."

18 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2008.
