## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO REDESIGNATE THE YEAR OF THE FAMILY  
AND TO MOVE THE YEAR OF THE FAMILY CELEBRATION FROM 2008 TO  
2009.

1           WHEREAS, House Concurrent Resolution No. 269 (2006) was  
2 adopted by the Twenty-third Legislature on April 24, 2006 to  
3 designate and celebrate 2008 as the Year of the Family and to  
4 establish a Family Celebration Commission to administer the  
5 celebration; and

7           WHEREAS, Executive Order 07-03 implemented designation of  
8 the year 2008 as the Year of the Family; and

9  
10          WHEREAS, the Family Celebration Commission was established  
11 in October, 2007; and

12  
13          WHEREAS, the Family Celebration Commission has recommended  
14 to the Governor that the Year of the Family be moved from 2008  
15 to 2009 in order to facilitate broader community involvement in  
16 a successful Year of the Family celebration; now, therefore,

18          BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
19 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
20 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that the Governor is  
21 requested to redesignate the Year of the Family and to move the  
22 Year of the Family celebration from 2008 to 2009; and

24          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
25 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and the  
26 Chairperson of the Family Celebration Commission.
