
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROMOTING HAWAII AS THE WORLD'S INTERFAITH HARMONY CAPITAL.

1 WHEREAS, much of the violence in the world arises out of
2 religious conflict; and

3
4 WHEREAS, religious conflict is often the result of
5 inadequate understanding of other religions; and

6
7 WHEREAS, an effective means for minimizing misunderstanding
8 between religions is to promote open channels of communication
9 between religious faiths; and

10
11 WHEREAS, the "aloha spirit" is recognized as an important
12 aspect of the Hawaiian culture and arises from the concepts of
13 understanding and acceptance; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the "aloha spirit" has allowed various interfaith
16 religious groups to promote dialogue and activities in a free
17 and open manner and to draw participation from a broad base
18 transcending religious faiths; and

19
20 WHEREAS, because of the "aloha spirit", Hawaii is uniquely
21 qualified to serve as a role model for the acceptance and
22 promotion of interfaith religious activities; now, therefore,

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
25 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
26 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that Hawaii should be
27 promoted as the world's Interfaith Harmony Capital; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Hawaii serve as a role model
30 for interfaith relations and host activities seeking to develop
31 and promote interfaith relations; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the All Believers Network, a
2 non-profit organization incorporated in the State of Hawaii, is
3 requested to establish the statewide interfaith steering
4 committee consisting of representatives from the various
5 religious and interfaith organizations and groups in Hawaii,
6 including but not limited to: Baha'i, Buddhism, Christianity,
7 Church Women United, Confucianism, Daoism, Hawaiian
8 Spirituality, Hinduism, Islam, Knights of Columbus, Jainism,
9 Judaism, Mokichi Okada Association, Native Americans, Church of
10 Perfect Liberty, Quakers, Risshio Kosei Kai, the Salvation Army,
11 Seichi-No Ie, Shinnyo-En, Shinto, Sikhism, Sufism, Unitarian
12 Universalism, Unity, Zoroastrianism, All Believers Network, the
13 Interfaith Alliance, and the Open Table; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that members of the statewide
16 interfaith steering committee are requested to select a
17 chairperson from amongst its members; and
18

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature requests that
20 the purpose of the statewide interfaith steering committee be to
21 develop and promote interfaith activities to further relations
22 between various religious faiths; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the statewide interfaith
25 steering committee is requested to explore the possibility of
26 organizing a major international interfaith conference in Hawaii
27 to take place by 2011; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is requested that the
30 statewide interfaith steering committee be terminated on
31 June 30, 2011; and

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
34 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the interfaith steering
35 committee at 781 Eleele Place, Honolulu, Hawaii 96825, which is
36 in turn requested to transmit copies to representatives of each
37 of the faiths and organizations listed in this Concurrent
38 Resolution.
