
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE MAYOR AND THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF MAUI COUNTY TO CREATE
A SEPARATE COUNTY CODE SPECIFICALLY FOR THE ISLAND OF
MOLOKAI.

1 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii is divided into four major
2 counties, Maui, Kauai, Hawaii, and the city and county of
3 Honolulu; and
4

5 WHEREAS, each county represents a separate island that is
6 unique and distinctive with its own culture, style, history, and
7 charm; and
8

9 WHEREAS, the island of Molokai is no exception, with an
10 exceptional and unique history, culture, and people that is
11 unlike any of its sister islands; and
12

13 WHEREAS, only because of its relatively small population,
14 Molokai falls under the jurisdiction of the county of Maui and
15 the Maui county code; and
16

17 WHEREAS, however, the uniqueness of Molokai warrants the
18 creation of a separate county code for Molokai; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
21 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
22 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that the Mayor and
23 County Council of Maui are urged to create a separate county
24 code specifically for the island of Molokai; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
27 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to Mayor and the
28 Chairperson of the Council of Maui County.
