
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONDUCT A
FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE REPAIR AND REPAVING OF SIDE
STREETS ALONG KALIHI STREET.

1 WHEREAS, in recent years, the poor condition of Honolulu's
2 streets has been widely criticized; and

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4 WHEREAS, streets have fallen into a state of disrepair,
5 thereby presenting a safety risk to children, kupuna, and all
6 pedestrians, and causing anguish to drivers and sometimes damage
7 to vehicles; and

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9 WHEREAS, while the City and County of Honolulu (C&C) has
10 taken great strides to clear the backlog of much-needed street
11 repairs and repaving, some areas are still in need of remedial
12 attention; and

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14 WHEREAS, one of these areas is Kalihi, where numerous side
15 streets are in need of repair and repaving; now, therefore,

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17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
18 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
19 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that C&C is requested to
20 conduct a feasibility study for the repair and repaving of side
21 streets along Kalihi Street; and

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23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study focuses specifically
24 on Kilohana Street, Waialele Street, Ahihi Street, Murphy Street,
25 Merkle Street, Noe Street, Laulani Street, Pahulu Street, Wahine
26 Place, Anuu Place, Manaiki Place, Akone Place, Mahani Loop,
27 Kuikele Street, Papali Place, and Kapali Street; and



1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that C&C is requested to submit a
2 report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature no
3 later than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session
4 of 2009; and

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6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
7 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City
8 and County of Honolulu.
