
HOUSE RESOLUTION

RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE STATE AUDITOR TO COMMISSION AN INDEPENDENT MEDICAL REVIEW OF THE APPROPRIATENESS OF THE CHART-BASED LEVEL OF CARE BY ALL MEDICAID PATIENTS WHO ARE NEONATAL OR PEDIATRIC INTENSIVE CARE PATIENTS BETWEEN THE YEARS OF 2007 AND 2000.

1 WHEREAS, in the past, using valid and reliable level of
2 care tools, neonatal and pediatric patients in intensive care
3 units (ICUs) have been found to be at a much lower level of
4 chart-based care than what is appropriate; now, therefore,
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6 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
7 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
8 Session of 2008, that this body respectfully requests the State
9 Auditor to review the appropriateness of the level of care by
10 all Medicaid patients who are neonatal or pediatric intensive
11 care patients between the years of 2007 and 2000; and
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13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Auditor is requested
14 to provide a report to the Legislature regarding their findings
15 of the appropriateness of the level of care, not later than 21
16 days prior to the convening of the 2009 Regular Session; and
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18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
19 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the State
20 Auditor, the Insurance Commissioner, the Director of the
21 Department of Health, the Director of the Department of Human
22 Services, Hawaii's Congressional Delegation.
