# HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII STATE COALITION AGAINST DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TO PROVIDE EDUCATION AND AWARENESS ON DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TO FAITH-BASED COMMUNITIES AND URGE THEIR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS TO SERVE AS SAFE HAVENS FOR VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

1           WHEREAS, domestic violence consists of behaviors used by  
2 one person in a relationship to control the other; and

3  
4           WHEREAS, domestic violence can occur in many forms such as  
5 psychological, emotional, or sexual abuse and can happen once or  
6 periodically to victims of any age, gender, race, culture,  
7 education level, employment or marital status, or religion; and

8  
9           WHEREAS, victims of abuse, particularly women and families  
10 in need, benefit not only from information about preventing,  
11 stopping or recognizing the warning signs of domestic violence  
12 or abuse, but they also need support from family and friends and  
13 others from their religious community that they trust; and

14  
15           WHEREAS, Hawaii's faith-based communities can be a source  
16 of support for victims of domestic violence and their religious  
17 organizations can be considered safe environments, where  
18 domestic violence victims and their family members can receive  
19 assistance, counseling, and referral services; and

20  
21           WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Coalition Against Domestic  
22 Violence is a private, not-for-profit statewide organization  
23 whose purpose is to end family violence in Hawaii by  
24 coordinating domestic violence prevention and intervention  
25 services, affecting public policy, and establishing coordinated  
26 and consistent procedures and actions by the civil and criminal  
27 justice systems in Hawaii; and

29           WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Coalition Against Domestic  
30 Violence provides education and training on family violence to  
31 service providers, collects resource materials and serves as a  
32 clearinghouse, provides technical assistance on family violence



1 matters, and provides facilitation when requested by member  
2 agencies; now, therefore,  
3

4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
5 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
6 Session of 2008, that the Hawaii State Coalition Against  
7 Domestic Violence is requested to provide education and  
8 awareness on domestic violence to faith-based communities and to  
9 urge their religious organizations to serve as safe havens for  
10 victims of domestic violence; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this  
13 Resolution be transmitted to the Hawaii State Coalition Against  
14 Domestic Violence, who in turn is requested to transmit copies  
15 to its member agencies.
