AND INNOVATION EXTENSION SERVICE.

6 average citizen outside of formal classrooms, an extension of
7 the local university was established to provide a service that
8 enabled consumers to keep up-to-date with trends and evolving
9 technology; and

11 WHEREAS, this "Extension Service" also enabled universities
12 to attract additional funding for research activities that would
13 directly benefit consumers; and

15 WHEREAS, our location at the hub of the Pacific and our
16 unique way of life put us in a position to be a model for
17 innovative thinking throughout the world; and

20 for renewable energy amplify the need for new ideas that can

25 Twenty-Fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
