
HOUSE RESOLUTION

SUBMITTING TO THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII FOR REVIEW
OF ACTION TAKEN BY THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES
ON LAND EXCHANGES.

1 WHEREAS, any exchange of public land for private land is
2 subject to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of
3 either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority
4 vote of both in any regular or special session pursuant to
5 section 171-50, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and

7 WHEREAS, Tiana Partners, a Hawaii general partnership, and
8 the Hawaiian Humane Society, a Hawaii nonprofit corporation, are
9 owners as tenants-in-common of land situate in Niu, Honolulu,
10 Oahu, identified as Tax Map Keys: (1) 3-7-04:01 (Parcel 1), 02
11 (Parcel 2), 20 (Parcel 20), and 21 (Parcel 21); and

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13 WHEREAS, Tiana Partners owns an undivided interest of
14 .479816032 in the land and the Hawaiian Humane Society owns an
15 undivided interest of .520183968 in the land; and

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17 WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Humane Society acquired its interest
18 in the land from Elisabeth J. K. L. Lucas by deeds dated
19 December 28, 1976, and December 30, 1982; and

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21 WHEREAS, the transfer of land to the Hawaiian Human Society
22 was subject to the condition that the property be used for the
23 benefit of the public for the operation of an educational
24 preserve for flora and fauna, to be made accessible as an
25 educational preserve for the public under the control of the
26 Hawaiian Humane Society, its successors and assigns, and, if not
27 used, then to the State of Hawaii, its successors and assigns,
28 for and as a public park; and

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30 WHEREAS, this condition on the Hawaiian Humane Society's
31 undivided interest in the land is a springing executory interest
32 in favor of the State of Hawaii that vests if the Hawaiian
33 Humane Society fails to use the land as specified; and
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1 WHEREAS, the lands are in a remote and steep area that is
2 not conducive for use as a public park; and

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4 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources'
5 Division of State Parks does not have adequate resources to
6 maintain the land as a park reserve; and

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8 WHEREAS, the portion of the land previously referred to as
9 parcel 2 is located within the Honolulu Watershed Forest Reserve
10 as established by Governor's proclamation dated October 13,
11 1913, as amended by Governor's proclamation dated December 24,
12 1926; Honolulu Watershed Forest Reserve; and

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14 WHEREAS, lands abutting parcel 2 along its easterly
15 boundary are public lands that are also within the Honolulu
16 Watershed Forest Reserve; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources'
19 Forestry and Wildlife Division considers parcel 2 to be a good
20 addition to the public holdings within the Honolulu Watershed
21 Forest Reserve for watershed protection and other public
22 purposes; and

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24 WHEREAS, Tiana Partners and the Hawaiian Humane Society are
25 proposing a land exchange pursuant to section 171-50, Hawaii
26 Revised Statutes, whereby Tiana Partners and the Hawaiian Humane
27 Society agree to allow the Hawaiian Humane Society to convey its
28 interest in parcels 1, 20, and 21 to Tiana Partners in exchange
29 for cash and other consideration, subject to the State of Hawaii
30 relinquishing its springing executory interest in the Hawaiian
31 Humane Society's undivided interest in the lands; and

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33 WHEREAS, in exchange for the State relinquishing its
34 springing executory interest in the Hawaiian Humane Society's
35 undivided interest in parcels 1, 20, and 21, Tiana Partners and
36 the Hawaiian Human Society agree to convey an undivided fee
37 simple interest in parcel 2 to the State; and

39 WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved
40 the proposed exchange involving the State's interest in land
41 known as parcels 1, 2, 20, and 21, in principle, at December 8,
42 2006, meeting under agenda item D-14; and



1 WHEREAS, at a December 14, 2007, meeting under agenda item
 2 D-15, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved to amend
 3 its prior action to reflect the parties' intent to exchange
 4 present and future interests in the land known as parcels 1, 2,
 5 20, and 21; and

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 7 WHEREAS, since section 171-50, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
 8 requires any exchange of public land for private land to be
 9 subject to disapproval by the Legislature, the Legislature
 10 should review the proposed land exchange; now, therefore,

 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 13 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
 14 Session of 2008, that the following exchange, approved by the
 15 Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board), be reviewed by the
 16 Legislature:
