## HOUSE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING AND CONGRATULATING JAMES CAMPBELL HIGH SCHOOL FOR  
ITS ACCOMPLISHMENTS.

1           WHEREAS, JAMES CAMPBELL HIGH SCHOOL, established in 1962,  
2 educates over 2,400 students from the 'Ewa Plain in grades 9-12,  
3 and continues to strive for academic and athletic achievement;

6           WHEREAS, under the coordination of JULIE DO, JAMES CAMPBELL  
7 HIGH SCHOOL was given approval to become first public school in  
8 Hawai'i to offer the International Baccalaureate Diploma  
9 Programme, a challenging college preparatory program covering a  
10 vast array of academic subjects; and

12           WHEREAS, under the leadership of Coach NATHAN MACADANGDANG,  
13 the JAMES CAMPBELL HIGH SCHOOL Varsity Girls Basketball Team  
14 captured the Division II title earning JAMES CAMPBELL HIGH  
15 SCHOOL its third state championship since 1978; and

17           WHEREAS, under the guidance of OSCAR RAMISCAL, students  
18 SHERWIN ACIDERA, ERIN GAMIL, and EVELYN OBAMOS won first place  
19 in the "Tell Me a Story" category of the statewide 2008 Island  
20 Movie Contest, took first place in the Public Broadcasting  
21 Corporation and Hawai'i Civil Rights Commission's Pono Video  
22 Awards, and the City and County of Honolulu's "Earth Month  
23 Video" competition in the "Best in Floatables Category"; and

25           WHEREAS, the JAMES CAMPBELL HIGH SCHOOL Navy Junior Reserve  
26 Officers' Training Corps, a distinguished unit for the past 11  
27 years, is the only school in Hawai'i, and one of twenty-three in  
28 the nation selected to attend the NJROTC National Academics,  
29 Athletics, and Drill Championships in Pensacola, Florida, the  
30 most comprehensive test of overall JROTC training and  
31 performance; and

1 WHEREAS, the Milken Family Foundation has recognized  
 2 MARITES BARANGAN, a teacher and graduate of JAMES CAMPBELL HIGH  
 3 SCHOOL as Hawai'i's recipient of the 2008 Teacher of Promise  
 4 Award; and

 6 WHEREAS, under the direction of Principal GAIL AWAKUNI,  
 7 2005 National High School Principal of the Year, JAMES CAMPBELL  
 8 HIGH SCHOOL continues to obtain one of the highest rates of  
 9 academic scholarship in Hawai'i, and is a recipient of the  
 10 Department of Education's Annual Achievement Award, Continuous  
 11 Improvement Award, and was recognized as a 2007-2008  
 12 Distinguished School; now, therefore,

 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
 15 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular  
 16 Session of 2008, that this body hereby recognizes and  
 17 congratulates the students, faculty and staff of JAMES CAMPBELL  
 18 HIGH SCHOOL for its exceptional academic and athletic  
 19 performance, and extends its warmest aloha and sincere best  
 20 wishes for continued success in all future endeavors.
