
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LEGISLATIVE BROADCAST PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that currently much time
2 and effort are expended in using a contractor to manually wire
3 each conference room of the state capitol for video broadcasts.
4 Completely hard-wiring the conference rooms would save money,
5 which can be used instead to enhance public programming.

6 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to wire
7 for video broadcasts all state capitol conference rooms used for
8 public hearings, the capitol auditorium, and both chambers.

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums, or so much
11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, for the
12 installation of wiring into all state capitol conference rooms
13 used for public hearings, the capitol auditorium, and both
14 chambers to allow for video broadcasts:

1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the senate and
2 the house of representatives, respectively, for the purposes of
3 this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
