A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PERINATAL CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 248, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is
- 2 amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of [\$400,000] \$200,000,
- 5 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year [2006-
- 6 $\frac{2007}{2008}$, and the same sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 7 necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009, to establish a pilot
- 8 perinatal clinic and provide case management services.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the [John A.
- 10 Burns school of medicine university clinical educational and
- 11 research associates program at the University of Hawaii
- 12 department of obstetrics, gynecology, and women's health]
- 13 department of human services for the purposes of this Act."
- 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 2007.
