A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 328L-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b)	The fund shall be used for the purpose of receiving
4	allocatin	g, and appropriating the tobacco settlement moneys as

6	(1)	Twenty-four and one-half per cent shall be
7		appropriated into the emergency and budget reserve
8		fund under section 328L-3;
9	(2)	Thirty-five per cent shall be appropriated to the
10		department for purposes of section 328L-4;
11	(3)	Twelve and one-half per cent shall be appropriated
12		into the Hawaii tobacco prevention and control trust
13		fund under section 328L-5; and
14	(4)	Twenty-eight per cent shall be appropriated into the
15		university revenue-undertakings fund created in
16		section [f]304A-2167[f], to be applied [solely] to
17		[the]:

.5 ,	The payment of the principal of and interest on,
2	and to generate required coverage, if any, for,
3	revenue bonds issued by the board of regents of
4	the University of Hawaii to finance the cost of
5	construction of a university health and wellness
6	center, including a new medical school facility,
7	to be situated on the island of Oahu, for the
8	succeeding fiscal year; and
9	(B) The payment of annual operating expenses incurred
10	by the new medical school facility;
11	provided that any moneys in excess of the amount
12	required to pay principal of and interest on, and to
13	generate required coverage, if any, for [such] the
14	revenue bonds in any fiscal year, shall be transferred
15	[as follows:
16	(A) To in the succeeding fiscal year in the
