A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DIAMOND HEAD STATE MONUMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The practice of imposing admission or entrance
- 2 fees to Diamond Head State Monument is tantamount to a tax on
- 3 the citizens of this state. The purpose of this bill is to
- 4 direct the Department of Land and Natural Resources, as
- 5 caretakers of that park, to discontinue the practice of imposing
- 6 admission or entrance fees.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 6E-32, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 9 "[(c)] The Diamond Head State Monument Plan, adopted by
- 10 the board of land and natural resources in November of 1979,
- 11 shall serve as the official document setting forth the future
- 12 direction of the Diamond Head State Monument.
- 13 The board of land and natural resources may amend the
- 14 monument plan from time to time with the review and
- 15 recommendations of the Diamond Head citizen advisory committee,
- 16 organized in October of 1977. The board shall not, however,

- 1 direct the imposition of admission or entrance fees to Diamond
- 2 Head State Monument."
- 3 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
