A BILL FOR AN ACT


RELATING TO CIGARETTE TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify that the moneys earmarked from the cigarette tax collected on each 2 cigarette sold pursuant to section 245-15, Hawaii Revised 3 4 Statutes, for deposit into the Hawaii cancer research special fund, the trauma system special fund, the emergency medical 5 services special fund, and the community health centers special 6 fund shall be assessed on a per cigarette basis. In addition, 7 8 this Act ensures that moneys are earmarked for each special fund 9 through 2011 and beyond.

10 SECTION 2. Section 245-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended to read as follows:

12 "§245-15 Disposition of revenues. All moneys collected 13 pursuant to this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury 14 as state realizations to be kept and accounted for as provided 15 by law; provided that, of the moneys collected under the tax 16 imposed pursuant to [section 245-3(a) that represents the

Report Title:

Health Research; Cigarette Tax

Description:

Clarifies that the cigarette tax money earmarked to fund the cancer research center of Hawaii, emergency medical services, trauma care, and community health centers shall be calculated on a per cigarette basis. (SB139 HD1)
