BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	"§46- Indemnification of counties. (a) A state agency
5	may enter into an indemnity agreement with a county. An
6	indemnity agreement between a state agency and a county may
7	provide that the State:
8	(1) Defend the county and its officers and employees from
9	claims made by public users; or
10	(2) Indemnify the county and its officers and employees
11	for losses incurred as a direct result of the public
12	use.
13	(b) To receive county assistance, services, rights, or
14	permission to use county property, or to provide services or
15	otherwise act as a vendor to county agencies, a state agency
16	shall agree in writing to an indemnity provision to:

1	(1)	Defend the county and its officers and employees from

6	(c)	Except as otherwise provided by law, an indemnity
7	provision	not in strict compliance with this section shall not
8	give rise	to a claim against the State under chapter 661 or
9	otherwise	waive the State's sovereign immunity."
10	SECT	ION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
11	matured, p	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
12	begun, bet	fore its effective date.
13	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
