A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the limitations on state and county liability have proven to be beneficial to the state and county governments, as well as the public. The
- 4 liability protections have reduced the exposure of the state and
- 5 county governments to substantial damages and, as a result, have
- ${f 6}$ allowed the state and county governments to keep public beach
- 7 parks with potentially dangerous conditions open to the public.
- $oldsymbol{8}$ The legislature further finds that state and county compliance
- ${f 9}$ with the statutorily required public warning of dangerous
- 10 conditions at public beach parks has contributed to an
- 11 improvement in public safety in these areas, which justifies
- 12 making the current liability exemptions for state and county
- 13 governments relating to public beach parks and actions of county
- 14 lifeguards permanent.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to make permanent certain
- 16 liability protections for the state and county governments
- 17 relating to public use of public beach parks. This Act also
