## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IOLANI PALACE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Iolani Palace is
- 2 a historic treasure, officially recognized by the State of
- 3 Hawaii. The palace has served as the seat of Hawaii's
- 4 government from the days of the monarchy through statehood,
- 5 until the present capitol building was constructed. Throughout
- 6 that time, the palace has relied upon private donations and
- 7 small state subsidies to operate. It is the intent of this Act
- 8 to provide relief to the palace by exempting the palace from the
- 9 standards and conditions related to the receipt of funds
- 10 contained in chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- The purpose of this Act is to exempt the Iolani Palace from
- 12 the standards and conditions related to the receipt of funds
- 13 contained in chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 6E-35, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:

- 1 "[+] \$6E-35[+] Iolani Palace. (a) The official
- 2 designation of the palace of the former monarchs of Hawaii shall
- 3 be Iolani Palace.
- 4 (b) The official designation of the Friends of Iolani
- 5 Palace shall be the State of Hawaii Museum of Monarchy History.
- 6 The qualifying standards and conditions related to the receipt
- 7 of funds contained in chapter 42F shall not apply to funds
- 8 received by the State of Hawaii Museum of Monarchy History;
- 9 provided that if the museum contracts with a recipient or
- 10 provider, then the qualifying standards, conditions, and other
- 11 provisions of chapter 42F shall apply to the recipient or
- 12 provider and the contract."
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
