A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 453-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b)	Nothing herein shall:
4	(1)	Apply to so-called Christian Scientists so long as
5		they merely practice the religious tenets of their
6		church without pretending a knowledge of medicine or
7		surgery;
8	(2)	Prohibit service in the case of emergency or the
9		domestic administration of family remedies;
10	(3)	Apply to any commissioned medical officer in the
11		United States armed forces or public health service
12		engaged in the discharge of one's official duty, nor
13		to any practitioner of medicine and surgery from
14		another state when in actual consultation, including
15		but not limited to $[-\tau]$ in-person, mail, electronic,
16		telephonic, fiber-optic, or other telemedicine
17		consultation with a licensed physician of this State
18		if the physician from another state at the time of

1		such	consultation is licensed to practice in the state
2		in wh	nich the physician resides; provided that:
3		(A)	The physician from another state shall not open
4			an office, or appoint a place to meet patients,
5			or receive calls within the limits of the State;
6			and
7		(B)	The licensed physician of this State retains
8			control and remains responsible for the provision
9			of care for the patient; and
10		provi	ded further that the laws and regulations
11		relat	ting to contagious diseases are not violated;
12	(4)	Proh	bit services rendered by any person certified
13		undei	part II of this chapter to provide emergency
14		medic	cal services, or any physician assistant, when the
15		servi	ces are rendered under the direction and control
16		of a	physician licensed in this State except for final
17		refra	action resulting in a prescription for spectacles,
18		conta	act lenses, or visual training as performed by an
19		oculi	ist or optometrist duly licensed by the State.
20		The o	direction and control shall not be construed in

every case to require the personal presence of the

supervising and controlling physician. Any physician

2		II o	f this chapter to provide emergency medical
3		serv	ices, or physician assistant, shall retain full
4		prof	essional and personal responsibility for any act
5		which	h constitutes the practice of medicine when
6		perf	ormed by such person or physician assistant; or
7 (5)	Proh	ibit [automatic] automated external defibrillation
8		by:	
9		(A)	Any first responder personnel certified by the
10			department of health to provide [automatic]
11			automated external defibrillation when it is
12			rendered under the medical oversight of a
13			physician licensed in this State; or
14		(B)	Any person [who successfully completes training
15			under an automatic external defibrillator program
16			administered by a physician. An "automatic
17			external defibrillator program" means an
18			appropriate training course that includes
19			cardiopulmonary resuscitation and proficiency in
20			the use of an automatic external defibrillator.
21			acting in accordance with section 663-1.5(e)."

1 SECTION 2. Section 663-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows: 3 "(e) Any person who [successfully completes training under any automatic external defibrillator program administered by a 4 physician shall not be liable for any civil damages resulting 5 6 from any act or omission while attempting] in good faith, without remuneration or expectation of remuneration, attempts to 7 resuscitate a person in immediate danger of loss of life when 8 9 administering any [automatic] automated external defibrillator, 10 regardless of where the [automatic] automated external defibrillator that is used is located, shall not be liable for 11 12 any civil damages resulting from any act or omission except as 13 may result from the person's gross negligence or wanton acts or 14 omissions. Any person, including an employer, who establishes an 15 16 [automatic] automated external defibrillator program shall not 17 be liable for any civil damages resulting from any act or 18 omission of the persons or employees trained under the program 19 who, in good faith and without remuneration or the expectation 20 of remuneration, attempt to resuscitate a person in immediate danger of loss of life by administering an [automatic] automated 21 22 external defibrillator.

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- 1 (f) Any physician who administers an [automatic] automated
- 2 external defibrillator program without remuneration or
- 3 expectation of remuneration shall not be liable for any civil
- 4 damages resulting from any act or omission involving the use of
- 5 an [automatic] automated external defibrillator, except as may
- 6 result from the physician's gross negligence or wanton acts or
- 7 omissions."
- 8 SECTION 3. Section 663-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 10 "(h) For the purposes of this section:
- "[Automatic] Automated external defibrillator program"
- 12 [shall have the meaning provided in section 453-2(b)(5)(B).]
- 13 means an appropriate training course that includes
- 14 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and proficiency in the use of an
- 15 automated external defibrillator.
- "Good faith" includes but is not limited to a reasonable
- 17 opinion that the immediacy of the situation is such that the
- 18 rendering of care should not be postponed.
- 19 "Rescue team" means a special group of physicians, basic
- 20 life support personnel, advanced life support personnel,
- 21 surgeons, nurses, volunteers, or employees of the owners or
- 22 operators of the hospital or authorized emergency vehicle who

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- 1 have been trained in basic or advanced life support and have
- 2 been designated by the owners or operators of the hospital or
- 3 authorized emergency vehicle to attempt to provide such support
- 4 and resuscitate persons who are in immediate danger of loss of
- 5 life in cases of emergency."
- 6 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
