

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII: 1 PART I 2 EDUCATIONAL WORKFORCE WORKING GROUP 3 SECTION 1. (a) There is established an educational 4 workforce working group within the department of labor and 5 industrial relations for administrative purposes only. The 6 chairperson of the workforce development council or the 7 chairperson's designee shall convene the first meeting of the educational workforce working group no later than August 1, 8 9 2007, at which time the members shall select a chair, to examine and address the following issues: 10 How well the workforce needs of Hawaii are currently 11 (1)12 being met; 13 How prepared the State is to meet the workforce needs (2)14 of the future: What recommendations can be made to improve Hawaii's 15 (3) 16 educational system to fulfill the workforce needs of 17 the future;

1	(4)	What is the current relationship between the public
2		schools and emerging industries;
3	(5)	What percentage of high school students participate in
4		any form of vocational or professional training
5		outside of the school setting;

8		the State's future workforce needs;
9	(7)	What are the challenges or impediments to creating a
10		more direct relationship between schools and economy-
11		driving industries of the State;
12	(8)	How might autonomous schools-within-schools, magnet
13		schools, specialized schools, and charter schools be
14		better used to create more direct links between high
15		schools and economy-driving industries of the State;
16		and
17	(9)	How might the size of public schools, the distribution
18		of discretionary funding, the decentralized authority
19		of school community councils or charter school local
20		school boards, and other organizational reforms be
21		better used to satisfy the workforce development needs
22		of the information and technology age.

14	(4)	The superintendent of education or the
15		superintendent's designee;
16	(5)	Two representatives from the University of Hawaii
17		system; provided that at least one shall be the
18		chancellor of a community college;

3	SECT	ION 3. The department of education shall include
4	within it	s strategic plan, plans to ensure optimal use of
5	technolog	y for administration, data collection, and data sharing
6	related t	o educational and workforce needs, and plans to ensure
7	that pers	onalized student education plans will provide a direct
8	link to economic and workforce needs.	
9	The	department of education shall submit a report
10	containing its five-year plan to the legislature no later than	
11	twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of	
12	2008.	
13	SECTION 4. The University of Hawaii shall prepare a report	
14	detailing:	
15	(1)	The current activities on each of its campuses to
16		prepare students with the skills and knowledge needed
17		to successfully enter and progress in the Hawaii
18		workforce;
19	(2)	The University of Hawaii's current plans to increase
20		the percentage of Hawaii high school graduates who
21		continue their education by enrolling at a University
22		of Hawaii campus and to increase the percentage of

students who earn degrees or certificates within one hundred fifty per cent of the planned length of the degree, particularly in fields where the State is experiencing shortages of qualified employees; and (3) Recommendations about additional steps the State needs to consider implementing to increase the number of qualified workers in the State.

8 The University of Hawaii shall submit the report to the
9 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
10 the regular session of 2008.

11 SECTION 5. (a) There is appropriated out of the general 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$125,000 or so much 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the 14 sum of \$50,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 15 year 2008-2009 for 2.0 (FTE) workforce development liaison 16 positions and 1.0 (FTE) support staff position within the department of education to assist the department of education in 17 18 coordinating workforce development efforts with the various departments, agencies, businesses, and organizations, including 19 20 the University of Hawaii and public school academies, within the 21 State to provide students with:

22 (1) Career exploration, awareness, and mentoring;

1	(2) Access to unpaid and paid internships and experiential	
2	learning opportunities; and	
3	(3) Job placement assistance;	
4	provided that the duties of the workforce development liaisons	
5	shall be divided into public sector and private sector	
6	relationships. The public sector liaison shall be responsible	
7	for coordinating workforce development efforts between the	
8	department of education and any department or agency of the	
9	State, the counties, or any political subdivisions thereof, and	
10 [°]	the private sector liaison shall be responsible for coordinating	
11	workforce development efforts between the department of	
12	education and businesses, nonprofit organizations, and other	
13	private sector organizations.	
14	(b) The workforce development liaisons shall also be	
15	responsible for:	
16	(1) Identifying future workforce need areas, such as	
17	nursing, teaching, science and technology, and	
18	agribusiness;	
19	(2) Working to establish new academies to support growth	
20	in workforce need areas;	
21	(3) Interfacing with the business community to determine	
22	what skill sets are necessary and to create mutually

1	beneficial relationships between the schools or
2	academies and businesses, including the development of
3	paid internships and facilitation of job
4	opportunities; and
5	(4) Assisting the public schools and the academies with
6	curriculum integration and other department of
7	education functions.
8	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9	of education for the purposes of this part.
10	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.

Education; Workforce Development

Description:

Establishes and appropriates funds for an educational workforce working group under the department of labor and industrial relations to examine and address workforce and workforce-related education issues. Requires the department of education to include in its strategic plan, plans for workforce-related needs. Requires the University of Hawaii to submit a report to the Legislature on its workforce development efforts. Appropriates funds for positions to assist the department of education with its workforce development efforts. (CD2)
