# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVER LICENSES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-108, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) The examiner of drivers may waive the knowledge test  
4 required under subsections (a) (2) and (a) (3) and the actual  
5 demonstration of ability to operate a motor vehicle for any  
6 person who is at least eighteen years of age and who possesses a  
7 valid driver's license issued to the applicant in any other  
8 state of the United States, the District of Columbia, the  
9 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Guam, a province of  
10 the Dominion of Canada, or the Commonwealth of the Northern  
11 Mariana Islands for the operation of vehicles in categories 1  
12 through 3 of section 286-102."

13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon approval;  
15 provided that the amendments made to section 286-108, Hawaii  
16 Revised Statutes, by this Act shall not be repealed when that



1 section is reenacted on January 9, 2011, pursuant to section 15  
2 of Act 72, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005.

Permits the examiner of drivers to waive the test of knowledge of the rules of the road for applicants holding a valid driver's license from another state of the United States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Guam, a province of the Dominion of Canada, or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
