### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$7,694,360, or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary, for defraying any and all
- 4 session and nonsession expenses of the senate up to and
- 5 including June 30, 2008, including the 2007 regular session,
- 6 twenty-fourth legislature of the State of Hawaii, and
- 7 pre-session expenses and the expenses of any committee or
- 8 committees established during the interim between the 2007 and
- 9 2008 regular sessions.
- 10 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 11 the senate.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$11,670,163, or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary, for defraying any and all
- 15 session and nonsession expenses of the house of representatives
- 16 up to and including June 30, 2008, including the 2007 regular
- 17 session, twenty-fourth legislature of the State of Hawaii, and

- 1 pre-session expenses and the expenses of any committee or
- 2 committees established during the interim between the 2007 and
- 3 2008 regular sessions.
- 4 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 5 the house of representatives.
- 6 SECTION 3. Payment of expenses of the senate during the
- 7 interim between the 2007 and 2008 regular sessions shall be made
- 8 only with the approval of the president of the senate, and
- 9 payment of expenses of the house of representatives during the
- 10 interim between the 2007 and 2008 sessions shall be made only
- 11 with the approval of the speaker of the house of
- 12 representatives.
- 13 SECTION 4. Before January 16, 2008, the senate and the
- 14 house of representatives shall each have their accounts audited
- 15 and a full report of the respective audits shall be presented to
- 16 the senate and to the house of representatives convening on
- 17 January 16, 2008.
- 18 SECTION 5. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the
- 19 expenses of any member of the legislature while traveling abroad
- 20 on official business of the legislature shall be \$130 a day as
- 21 authorized by the president of the senate and the speaker of the
- 22 house of representatives, respectively.

1	SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general

2	joint action of the president of the senate and			
3	the speaker of the house of representatives.			
4	The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by			
5	the auditor.			
6	SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general			
7	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,221,820, or so			
8	much thereof as may be necessary, to the office of the auditor			
9	during fiscal year 2007-2008 to be deposited into the audit			
10	revolving fund established pursuant to section 23-3.6, Hawaii			
11	Revised Statutes.			
12	SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the audit			
13	revolving fund the sum of \$5,600,438, or so much thereof as may			
14	be necessary, to the office of the auditor during fiscal year			
15	2007-2008, for the auditor to conduct or complete its audit			
16	functions as provided by law.			
17	The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by			
18	the auditor.			
19	SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general			
20	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,223,008, or so			
21	much thereof as may be necessary, to the legislative reference			
22	bureau for defraying the expenses of the legislative reference			

- 1 bureau during fiscal year 2007-2008, including equipment
- 2 relating to computer systems programming and operations.
- 3 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 4 the legislative reference bureau.
- 5 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$971,500, or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary, to the office of the ombudsman for
- 8 defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year
- 9 2007-2008.
- 10 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 11 the ombudsman.
- 12 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums, or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary, for defraying the expenses of the
- 15 legislative information system:
- 16 (1) \$900,000 to the senate; and
- 17 (2) \$900,000 to the house of representatives.
- 18 This appropriation shall be used to pay for hardware, software,
- 19 consultant, installation, material, supply, and other related
- 20 costs associated with the legislative information system that
- 21 have been or will be incurred.

- 1 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$175,000, or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary, for the legislative broadcast 4 program, including the production and distribution of television 5 broadcasts of legislative proceedings. The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by 6 7 the legislature for the purposes of this section. 8 SECTION 13. Except for moneys in the audit revolving fund, as of the close of business on June 30, 2008, the unexpended or 9 10 unencumbered balance of any appropriation made by this Act shall 11 lapse into the general fund. 12 SECTION 14. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 13 and 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has 14 15 determined that the appropriations contained in this Act will 16 cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be exceeded by \$ 17 , or per cent. The 18 reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are 19 that the appropriations made in this Act are necessary to serve 20 the public interest and to meet the needs provided by this Act.
- 21 SECTION 15. Each section of this Act is declared to be
- 22 severable from the remainder of this Act.

1 SECTION 16. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
