A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS FOR HAWAII PREPARATORY ACADEMY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds and declares that the
- 2 issuance of special purpose revenue bonds under this Act is in
- 3 the public interest and for the public's general welfare.
- 4 SECTION 2. Pursuant to part VIII, chapter 39A, Hawaii
- 5 Revised Statutes, the department of budget and finance, with the
- 6 approval of the governor, is authorized to issue special purpose
- 7 revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$50,000,000, in one or
- 8 more series, for the purpose of assisting Hawaii Preparatory
- 9 Academy to finance or refinance the planning, construction, and
- 10 improvement of its educational facilities in the State. The
- 11 legislature finds that the planning, construction, and
- 12 improvement of facilities of Hawaii Preparatory Academy
- 13 constitute a project for purposes of part VIII, chapter 39A,
- 14 Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the financing thereof is assistance
- 15 to a not-for-profit private elementary and secondary school that
- 16 serves the general public.

         SECTION 3. The special purpose revenue bonds authorized by

    this Act shall be issued pursuant to part VIII, chapter 39A,

    Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to the power to issue special
    purpose revenue bonds to assist not-for-profit private

    nonsectarian and sectarian elementary schools, secondary

    schools, colleges, and universities that serve the general

    public.

         SECTION 4. The special purpose revenue bonds issued under

    this Act may be issued in one or more series for a single
    project, multiple projects, a single-project party, or multiple-

    project parties pursuant to the authority of this Act or the

    combined authority of this Act and any one or more other

    separate acts of the legislature pursuant to part VIII, chapter

    39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the department of budget and
    finance may combine into a single issue of special purpose

    revenue bonds, in one or more series, two or more proposed

    issues of special purpose revenue bonds to be issued pursuant to

    part VIII, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, separately

    authorized, in the total amount not to exceed the aggregate of

         SECTION 5. The department of budget and finance is further

- 1 subsequent to June 30, 2012, refunding special purpose revenue
- 2 bonds authorized in such principal amounts as the department
- 3 shall determine to be necessary to refund the special purpose
- 4 revenue bonds authorized in section 2. Such refunding special
- 5 purpose revenue bonds may be issued in one or more series for
- 6 the refunding of the special purpose revenue bonds authorized in
- 7 section 2 and may be combined into a single issue of refunding
- 8 revenue special purpose revenue bonds, in one or more series,
