# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that envisioning and 1 2 planning for Hawaii in the new century is complex and multifaceted. The education of the citizenry, including early 3 childhood through K-12 schooling to college and career and work 4 force training, has and will always be of critical importance. 5 The legislature believes that the vision and plans for education 6 and schools at mid-century cannot be initiated too early. The 7 Hawaii P-20 Initiative is a consortium of public and private 8 educators, governmental officials, and community leaders working 9 10 together to improve learner achievement in Hawaii.

11 The purpose of this Act is to provide the impetus for 12 developing the vision and plans for education in Hawaii for the 13 coming century by funding the Hawaii P-20 Initiative to develop 14 and initiate plans for education in Hawaii in the new century. 15 SECTION 2. The Hawaii P-20 Initiative Council shall 16 develop and initiate plans for education in Hawaii in the new 17 century, including identifying contributors and planners,



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1 creating a vision, goals, objectives, and timelines, and 2 organizing meetings and electronic communication. The general 3 goals of the effort will be to ensure an engaged, responsible, 4 and productive citizenry in Hawaii in the new century that is the expected result of an education system and schools that are 5 coordinated and articulated from earliest teaching to career and 6 workforce preparation and to promote lifelong learning. 7 8 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000, or so much 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the 10 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 11 12 2008-2009, for the Hawaii P-20 Initiative to develop and 13 initiate plans for education in Hawaii in the new century. 14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act. 15 16 SECTION 4. The Hawaii P-20 Initiative Council shall 17 prepare progress reports for the legislature no later than the last day of each calendar year for which it is funded by this 18 and future Acts. 19

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SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
