
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DESIGNATION OF A HAWAII ARCHAEOLOGICAL DATA SURVEY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§6E- Archaeological data survey; designation. (a) A
5 Hawaii archaeological data survey is established and designated
6 as a program of the State of Hawaii Museum of Natural and
7 Cultural History. The survey shall be an on-line database of
8 archaeological documents and materials, including but not
9 limited to, reports, maps, archived documents, and artifacts
10 obtained through archaeological work in Hawaii, beginning with
11 the collections of Bishop Museum. To expand the use and
12 knowledge of Hawaii's archaeological artifacts, the data survey
13 shall be conducted and maintained in consultation with the
14 department of land and natural resources and other appropriate
15 organizations.

16 (b) The museum, in consultation with the office of
17 Hawaiian affairs, may withhold from the database, temporarily or



1 permanently, information that is not required to be disclosed
2 under section 92F-13(3), due to a valid threat that disclosure
3 may frustrate the legitimate government function of protecting
4 valuable archaeological sites and artifacts."

5 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.



Report Title:

Archaeological Data Survey; Established

Description:

Establishes and designates an archaeological data survey as an on-line database program of the State of Hawaii museum of natural and cultural history, beginning with the collections of Bishop Museum; authorizes the museum, in consultation with the office of Hawaiian affairs, to withhold from the database, either temporarily or permanently, information that may pose a threat to the protection of valuable archaeological sites and artifacts.
