16	(3)	A payroll card issued by an employer to an employee;
17	<u>(4)</u>	A prepaid calling card used to make wireline and
18		wireless calls;

1	(5)	An insurance claim card used to pay an insurance

3	(6)	A government benefit card, including a gift
4		certificate used to pay government benefits to a
5		person;

8	(9)	A meal card used to purchase any food or beverage at a
9		restaurant or cafeteria, including restaurants or
