
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SMALL BUSINESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The small business regulatory review board
2 shall convene a working group to review the process and
3 procedures related to rulemaking, as established under chapter
4 201M, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

5 (b) The working group shall include, but not be limited
6 to, representatives of small business organizations, the
7 department of business, economic development, and tourism, the
8 department of commerce and consumer affairs, and others as
9 deemed appropriate. The chairperson of the small business
10 regulatory review board shall serve as chair of the working
11 group.

12 (c) The working group shall review and make
13 recommendations regarding the rulemaking provisions under
14 chapter 201M, Hawaii Revised Statutes, in particular:

15 (1) Whether the current statutes are adequate to meet the
16 concerns of small business;



1 (2) What concerns have been raised by small businesses,
2 the small business regulatory review board, or
3 government agencies in implementing the statutes;

4 (3) The level of difficulty in adequately meeting the
5 requirements of the statutes; and

6 (4) Any other issues that may arise during the review.

7 (d) The small business regulatory review board shall
8 submit the findings and recommendations of the working group,
9 including any legislation necessary to implement the
10 recommendations, to the legislature no later than twenty days
11 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2009.

12 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
