
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE U.S. NAVY TO CLEAR THE COASTLINE OF LOWER WAIPAHU
THAT IS UNDER ITS JURISDICTION FROM INVASIVE PLANT-LIFE AND
EXCESSIVE FOLIAGE FOR SAFETY AND AESTHETIC PURPOSES.

1 WHEREAS, the shoreline of lower Waipahu has, in recent
2 years, become subject to significant overgrowth by various
3 invasive plant species and excessive foliage, therefore creating
4 not only a shabby appearance, but also a safety hazard and an
5 area where illicit activities may potentially transpire; and

7 WHEREAS, the shoreline along West Loch and Middle Loch
8 within the U.S. Navy's jurisdiction is strewn with abandoned
9 vehicles, tires, white goods, and other discarded debris; now,

12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
13 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
14 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that the U.S. Navy is
15 requested to clear the section of lower Waipahu adjacent to West
16 Loch Estates that is under its jurisdiction from invasive plant-
17 life and excessive foliage for safety and aesthetic purposes;

21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President, National
22 Security Advisor, Secretary of Defense, and Deputy Secretary of
23 Defense of the United States, the Chair and all members of the
24 United States Joint Chiefs of Staff, all members of the White
25 House National Security Council, the Secretaries of the United
26 States Air Force, Army, and Navy, the Commander of the United
27 States Pacific Command (CDRUSPACOM), the Commander of the United
28 States Pacific Fleet (USPACFLT), the Waipahu Community
29 Association, the Chair of the Waipahu Neighborhood Board, and
30 the Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu.
