A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GASOLINE DEALERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 486H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 repealed.

3 SECTION 2. Act 242, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, is
4 amended by repealing section 8.

5 ~~["SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2004-2005, to carry
8 out the purposes of chapter 486H and this Act, including the
9 hiring of necessary staff and the retaining of professional
10 consultants, without regard to chapters 76 and 103D for the
11 purposes of this Act. The sum appropriated shall be expended by
12 the public utilities commission."]~~

13 SECTION 3. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance of any
14 appropriation made by section 8 of Act 242, Session Laws of
15 Hawaii 2004, as of the close of business on the effective date
16 of this Act shall lapse into the general fund.


