# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FOURTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$4,865,000, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year  
5 2007-2008, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for  
6 the fourteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7       1. Governor Sanford B. Dole middle school

8       A. Campus safety and security  
9       improvements,

10       Phase I: design and construction  
11       for various improvements, ground,  
12       and site improvements, equipment,  
13       and appurtenances

14       Design                                       \$ 50,000

15       Construction                                 \$175,000

6 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
8 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are  
9 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations  
10 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
12 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
13 department of education for the purposes of this Act; provided  
14 that item 4 in section 1 shall be expended by the department of  
15 health.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
