A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE ADULT MENTAL HEALTH DIVISION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- This Act is recommended for immediate passage 1 SECTION 1.
- in accordance with section 9 of article VII of the Constitution 2
- 3 of the State of Hawaii.
- SECTION 2. Although funds were appropriated to the 4
- 5 department of health for adult mental health services for the
- fiscal period beginning July 1, 2006 and ending June 30, 2007, a 6
- 7 funding emergency now exists. The program will expend all
- appropriated funds before the end of the current fiscal year, 8
- and the department will be unable to meet its fiscal obligation 9
- 10 to provide services to certain adults with severe mental
- 11 illness.
- Over the past four fiscal years, the adult mental health 12
- division has served an increasing number of eligible mental 13
- health consumers and has provided an increased number of crisis 14
- outreach, eligibility determination, homeless outreach, and jail 15
- diversion services. This emergency appropriation is to continue 16
- existing services to meet the needs of the expanding eligible 17

- 1 population and to continue funding of required services
- 2 developed during the fiscal year. This increase in services and
- 3 the number of consumers served first resulted from the
- 4 settlement agreement and subsequent orders in United States of
- 5 America v. State of Hawaii, Civil Number 91-00137 (DAE/KSC), and
- 6 continues in response to the need for the public mental health
- 7 services adult mental health division provides.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate emergency funds
- 9 for ongoing services of the adult mental health division.
- 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$7,542,043, or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 13 ongoing services provided by the adult mental health division.
- 14 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 15 department of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 5. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 17 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 18 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
- 19 that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2006-
- 20 2007 (established at \$5,357,987,705 on November 8, 2006) has
- 21 already been exceeded by \$90,137,694 or 1.68 per cent. The
- 22 appropriations contained in this Act will cause the state

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- 1 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be
- 2 exceeded by an additional \$7,542,043, or an additional 0.141 per
- 3 cent. The calculation contained in the foregoing sentence
- 4 relates only to the amount of general funds appropriated in this
- 5 Act for fiscal year 2006-2007. The reasons for exceeding the
- 6 general fund expenditure ceiling are that the appropriations
- 7 made in this Act are necessary to serve the public interest and
- 8 to meet the needs provided for by this Act.
- 9 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
