# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 286-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended as follows:  
3           1. By amending subsection (b) to read:  
4           "(b) All other vehicles, with the exception of light  
5 passenger vehicles, including motorcycles, trailers,  
6 semitrailers, and pole trailers having a gross vehicle weight  
7 rating of 10,000 pounds or less, and antique motor vehicles as  
8 defined in section 249-1, except those in subsections (c) and  
9 (d), shall be certified as provided in subsection (e) every  
10 twelve months; provided that any vehicle to which this  
11 subsection applies shall not require inspection within two years  
12 of the date on which the vehicle was first sold."

13           2. By amending subsection (d) to read:  
14           "(d) Every vehicle, with the exception of light passenger  
15 vehicles unless found to be in violation of section 286-21 or  
16 286-22, shall be certified prior to the issuance of a temporary  
17 or permanent registration by the director of finance and prior




1 to the transfer of any registration; provided that this  
2 requirement shall not apply to a subsequent transfer of  
3 registration in a vehicle that carries a current certificate of  
4 inspection."

5 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
