
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is vital to the
2 health and safety of the residents and visitors of Oahu, that
3 the Oahu emergency medical services be equipped with the
4 necessary facilities, vehicles, equipment, and supplies to
5 efficiently and effectively serve this community. The purpose
6 of this Act is provide funding for two fully-equipped
7 ambulances, including lights, radio, docking station and wiring
8 for computer connectivity, gurney, decals, and two lifepak 12
9 defibrillators to the department of health per year.

10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
13 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
14 year 2008-2009, for two ambulances, the vehicles and equipment,
15 per year for the Oahu emergency medical services.

16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
17 of health for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
4 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5 year 2008-2009, for two lifepak 12 defibrillators per year for
6 the Oahu emergency medical services.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
8 of health for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
