A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIFTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$63,247,119, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2007-2008, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the fifteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Salt Lake waterway

8 Structural best management practices

1 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
8 expended by the department of accounting and general services,
9 in the case of item 1, the department of education, in the case
10 of items 2 to 18, and 20, and the department of transportation,
11 in the case of item 19, for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
