4 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
5 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
6 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
7 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
8 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

9 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
10 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
11 expended by the department of education, in the case of items 1  
12 to 9, the department of Hawaiian home lands, in the case of item  
13 10, and the department of transportation, in the case of items  
14 11 to 15, for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
