A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$40,741,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2007-2008, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the first senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Hilo high school

8 Design, construction, and
9 equipment for a gymnasium,
10 including the demolition of the
11 existing gym, if necessary, ground
12 and site improvements, equipment,
13 and appurtenances.

19 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 20 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 21 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is



1 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
4 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended as
5 follows:

- 6 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 to 5 shall be
7 expended by the department of education;
- 8 (2) The sum appropriated in item 6 shall be expended by
9 the department of health; and
- 10 (3) The sums appropriated in item 7 shall be expended by
11 the department of land and natural resources.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
