# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC CODE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part XI to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§291C-     Parking of oversized vehicles prohibited. (a)

5 No person shall park, let stand, idle, or otherwise remain  
6 motionless, without regard to the posting of any parking sign,  
7 any bus, truck, truck-trailer, trailer, van, house trailer, or  
8 other vehicle whose gross vehicle weight rating is 10,000 pounds  
9 or more, or whose vehicle length from bumper to bumper is twenty  
10 feet or more, for more than two hours on any residential roadway  
11 or street; provided that the vehicle shall be subject to all  
12 applicable traffic laws during the time while so parked.

13           (b) This section shall not apply to:

14           (1) Construction equipment and public utility vehicles if  
15           the equipment and vehicles are in use for repair or  
16           construction work while parked; and



1        (2) Vehicles used in unloading of goods, wares, or  
 2        merchandise if the vehicles are in use for those  
 3        purposes while parked."

4        SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

5        SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
