14 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
 15 improvement projects enumerated in section 1 and authorized by  
 16 this Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for  
 17 which the appropriation is made; provided that all moneys from  
 18 the appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse  
 19 as of that date.

20 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 21 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
 22 expended by the department of land and natural resources, in the



1 case of item 1, the department of water of the county of Kauai,  
 2 in the case of items 2 to 7, the county of Kauai, in the case of  
 3 items 8 and 9, the department of transportation, in the case of  
 4 item 10, and the department of education, in the case of items  
 5 11 to 16 for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 4. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
 7 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ , or so much  
 8 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much  
 9 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year  
 10 2008-2009, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for  
 11 the seventh senatorial district, as follows:
