A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR IRRIGATION SYSTEMS AND RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. A reliable irrigation system is the lifeblood
- 2 of Hawaii's agricultural industry. To ensure that Hawaii's
- 3 crops receive a steady and dependable supply of water,
- 4 sufficient funding is needed to maintain and improve Hawaii's
- 5 irrigation systems.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to:
- 7 (1) Reauthorize funds approved last year for the repair
- 8 and maintenance of irrigation systems throughout the
- 9 State; and
- 10 (2) Appropriate funds for capital improvement projects for
- irrigation systems throughout the State.
- 12 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 13 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$11,000,000, or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary, shall be deposited into the
- 16 irrigation repair and maintenance special fund for the repair
- 17 and maintenance of irrigation systems as follows:

- 1 (1)\$1,500,000 for the East Kauai irrigation system; 2 (2) \$2,000,000 for the Waimanalo irrigation system; 3 (3) \$2,500,000 for the Molokai irrigation system; 4 (4)\$1,500,000 for the Upcountry Maui irrigation system; 5 (5) \$1,000,000 for the Kau irrigation system; \$1,000,000 for the Honomalino irrigation system; 6 (6) \$1,500,000 for the Wahiawa reservoir and ditch system; 7 (7)and 8 9 (8) Other privately-owned irrigation systems on former 10 sugarcane and pineapple plantation lands that have 11 been converted to diversified agriculture. 12 There is appropriated, for projects under SECTION 3. section 2 of this Act, out of the irrigation repair and 13 14 maintenance special fund under section 167-24, Hawaii Revised 15 Statutes, the sum of \$11,000,000, or so much thereof as may be 16 necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008. The projects are deemed 17 necessary to qualify for federal aid financing or reimbursement. 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 19 agriculture for purposes of this Act. 20 SECTION 4. The director of finance is authorized to issue 21 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$7,036,000, or so much 22 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much

- 1 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
- 2 2007-2008, for the repair and maintenance of irrigation systems
- 3 as follows:
- 4 (1) \$2,336,000 for the East Kauai irrigation system;
- 5 (2) \$500,000 for the Waimanalo irrigation system;
- 6 (3) \$2,500,000 for the Molokai irrigation system; and
- 7 (4) \$1,700,000 for the Lower Hamakua irrigation system.
- 8 SECTION 5. There is appropriated, for projects under
- 9 section 4 of this Act, out of the general revenues of the State
- 10 of Hawaii, the sum of \$7,036,0000, or so much thereof as may be
- 11 necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008. The projects are deemed
- 12 necessary to qualify for federal aid financing or reimbursement.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 agriculture for purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 6. The appropriation made for the capital
- 16 improvement projects authorized in this Act shall not lapse at
- 17 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are
- 18 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
- 19 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.
- 20 SECTION 7. The sums appropriated for the respective
- 21 capital projects set forth in section 3 shall be expended by the
- 22 department of agriculture for purposes of this Act.
