BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 121-45, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§121-45 Tuition assistance for Hawaii national guard personnel to attend the University of Hawaii. (a) The adjutant 4 5 general, subject to the availability of funds, may award tuition assistance to qualified enlisted persons, warrant officers, and 6 [company grade] officers [(0-1 through 0-3)] in the Hawaii 7 8 national guard who are: 9 Residents of the State, as defined by the board of (1)regents pursuant to section [+]304A-402[+]; and 10 [Undergraduate_students] Students working toward a 11 (2)12 degree on any campus of the University of Hawaii." 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, to 15 provide tuition assistance to members of the Hawaii national 16 guard who are students working toward a degree on any campus of 17 18 the University of Hawaii system.
