A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGAL REQUIREMENTS FOR NEIGHBORHOOD BOARD MEETINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and to read
- 3 as follows:
- 4 "PART . NEIGHBORHOOD BOARD
- 5 §92-A Neighborhood board; notice and agenda; public input;
- 6 quorum. (a) Any contrary provision in this chapter
- 7 notwithstanding, the provisions of this part shall apply to
- 8 neighborhood boards overseen by a neighborhood commission in a
- 9 county with a population of 500,000 or more.
- 10 (b) The agenda required to be included in written public
- 11 notice of a neighborhood board meeting may include an
- 12 opportunity for the board to receive public input on issues not
- 13 specifically noticed for consideration at the forthcoming
- 14 meeting.
- 15 (c) Any matter raised as part of the public input agenda
- 16 allowed under subsection (b) may be discussed, and information
- 17 on the matter may be received by the board at the meeting;
- 18 provided that the board shall not make a decision relating to

- 1 the matter. The board may make decisions on matters originally
- 2 raised as part of a public input agenda only at a later meeting,
- 3 the agenda for which shall give notice of decision-making on the
- 4 matter.
- 5 (d) A quorum for a meeting of a neighborhood board shall
- 6 be required for:
- 7 (1) Conducting official board business;
- 8 (2) Discussions prior to and related to voting; and
- 9 (3) Voting required to validate an act of the board as
- part of official board business.
- 11 A neighborhood board may receive information or testimony on a
- 12 matter of official board business without a quorum; provided
- 13 that the board shall not make a decision on the issue; provided
- 14 further that any information or testimony received will be
- 15 permitted again at a subsequent meeting when the decision is
- 16 made.
- 17 §92-B Permitted interactions of neighborhood board
- 18 members. (a) Two or more members of a neighborhood board, but
- 19 less than the number of members necessary to constitute a quorum
- 20 for the board, may attend informational meetings or
- 21 presentations on matters relating to official board business,
- 22 including meetings of another entity, seminars, and community

- 1 meetings; provided that the presentation is not specifically and
- 2 exclusively organized for or directed toward members of the
- 3 board.
- 4 (b) Neighborhood board members may participate in
- 5 discussions, including discussions among themselves; provided
- 6 that:
- 7 (1) The discussions occur during and as part of the
- 8 informational meeting or presentation allowed by
- 9 subsection (a); and
- 10 (2) No commitment to vote is made or sought.
- 11 The board members, at the next duly noticed meeting of the
- 12 neighborhood board, shall report their attendance and the
- 13 matters presented and discussed that related to official board
- 14 business at the informational meeting or presentation.
- 15 §92-C Neighborhood board meeting; unanticipated events;
- 16 public interest. An unanticipated event that occurs after
- 17 public notice of a neighborhood board meeting has been issued,
- 18 but before the scheduled meeting, may be the subject of
- 19 discussion and deliberation at the scheduled meeting if:
- 20 (1) Timely action on the matter is urgently necessary for
- 21 public health, welfare, and safety; and

1 (2) Time does not allow for it to be addressed by an 2 emergency meeting scheduled pursuant to section 92-8. 3 At the duly noticed meeting, a board may take such action on an unanticipated event that meets the requirement of this section 4 5 in the same manner as if the board had held an emergency meeting pursuant to section 92-8 to take action on the issue." 6 7 SECTION 2. In codifying the new sections added by section 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute 8 9 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating the new sections in this Act. 10

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
