# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPEEDING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 291C-105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3           "(a) ~~[No person shall drive]~~ A person commits the offense  
4 of excessive speeding if:

5           (1) The person drives a motor vehicle at a speed  
6 exceeding:

7           ~~[(1)]~~ (A) The applicable state or county speed limit by  
8 thirty miles per hour or more; or

9           ~~[(2)]~~ (B) Eighty miles per hour or more irrespective of the  
10 applicable state or county speed limit~~[-]~~; or

11           (2) The person:

12           (A) Drives a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding the  
13 applicable state or county speed limit; and

14           (B) Has been determined to have committed, within the  
15 twelve months preceding the violation under this  
16 section, three or more offenses under this part."




1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
3 begun, before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
