A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE HERITAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. **Hawaii heritage task force.** (a) There is
2 established a Hawaii heritage task force to protect unique sites
3 and buildings that characterize Hawaiian culture and heritage.
4 The task force shall establish and maintain the Hawaii heritage
5 list. The list shall be comprised of sites and buildings
6 determined worthy of preservation and protection from demolition
7 and not already part of the historic preservation division's
8 inventory of historic properties. The task force shall consist
9 of fifteen members as follows:

10 (1) One member residing in each of the counties of Maui,
11 Kauai, and Hawaii;

12 (2) Two members residing in the city and county of
13 Honolulu;

14 (3) Three non-governmental experts from each of the
15 disciplines of architecture, archaeology, and history
16 and culture;

17 (4) The director or director's designee from the
18 department of land and natural resources;



- 1 (5) The governor or governor's designee;
- 2 (6) Two members from the senate appointed by senate
- 3 president;
- 4 (7) Two members from the house of representatives
- 5 appointed by the speaker of the house of
- 6 representatives; and
- 7 (8) The director or director's designee from the
- 8 department of business, economic development, and
- 9 tourism.

10 (b) The members shall serve without compensation but shall
11 be allowed their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the
12 performance of their duties.

13 (c) The task force is established within the department of
14 land and natural resources for administrative purposes only.

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to carry
18 out the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
20 department of land and natural resources.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
