# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$11,648,000, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year  
5 2008-2009, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for  
6 the first senatorial district, as follows:

7       1.    Wailoa small boat harbor, Hilo

8           A.    Design and construction for a two-  
9                lane boat launch ramp with fifteen  
10               per cent ramp angle, to be located  
11               within Wailoa small boat harbor,  
12               Suisan Basin along the west makai  
13               dock with boat wash down area,  
14               parking for truck and boat  
15               trailers, and access roadway.

16           Design	\$250,000
17           Construction	\$2,000,000

2	2. Hilo high school, Hawaii	
3	A. Design, construction, and	
4	equipment for a new gymnasium that	
5	will also serve as an emergency	
6	shelter, to include demolition of	
7	the existing gym if necessary;	
8	ground and site improvements;	
9	equipment and appurtenances.	
10	Design	\$100,000
11	Construction	\$9,198,000
12	Equipment	\$100,000
13	Total funding	\$9,398,000

14 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
16 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
17 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
18 of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

19 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
20 capital projects set forth in section 1(1) shall be expended by  
21 the department of transportation for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective  
2 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1(2) shall be  
3 expended by the department of education for the purposes of this  
4 Act.

5 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
