A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§302A- Participation in extracurricular activities by
5 home schooled children. (a) As used in this section,
6 "extracurricular activity" means a school authorized or
7 education-related activity occurring during or outside the
8 regular instructional school day, including, but not limited to,
9 sports, cheerleading, music, band, clubs, and other programs.

10 (b) A child who is home schooled in accordance with
11 section 302A-1132 is eligible to participate in extra curricular
12 activities at the public school that the child would otherwise
13 be required to attend. A home schooled child who wishes to
14 participate in an extracurricular activity must meet the
15 participation requirements and restrictions for that activity,
16 including, but not limited to, maintaining appropriate grade
17 point averages and paying appropriate fees, so long as such



1 requirements or restrictions are not inconsistent with this
2 section.


3 (c) The department shall adopt rules to effectuate this
4 section and to provide procedures by which a home schooled child
5 may apply to participate in extracurricular activities. The
6 department may also adopt rules setting forth which programs
7 qualify as extracurricular activities under this section."

8 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Home schooling; Extracurricular activities

Description:

Creates a new section allowing children who are home schooled to participate in extracurricular activities at the public school they would otherwise be required to attend.
