RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 171-43, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$171-43 Lease of campsites or sites for youth athletic
- 4 [and/or] or educational activities. The board of land and
- 5 natural resources may directly lease without recourse to public
- 6 auction to any eleemosynary or religious organization campsites
- 7 or sites for youth athletic [and/or] or educational activities,
- 8 including but not limited to fishing, ocean and marine
- 9 conservation, and forestry, in a state park area or on lands
- 10 under the control of the department of land and natural
- 11 resources at nominal consideration. Where the lease is for
- 12 campsites, the lease shall provide that the lessee shall permit
- 13 the public to use the campsites at the rates approved by the
- 14 board in its rules and regulations. Except as provided herein,
- 15 the terms and conditions of sections 171-33, 171-35, and 171-36
- 16 shall apply."

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
