A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the
3 sources of funding indicated below to program planning,
4 analysis, and budgeting (BUF 101) the following sums, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, to fund for the 2008-2009 fiscal
6 year all collective bargaining cost items in the agreement
7 negotiated with the exclusive bargaining representative of
8 collective bargaining unit (5):

14 SECTION 2. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part
15 shall be allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate
16 state departments for expenditure for the purposes of this part.



PART II

SECTION 3. There are appropriated or authorized from the sources of funding indicated below to program planning, analysis and budgeting (BUF 101) the following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund for fiscal year 2008-2009 the salary increases and other cost adjustments authorized by chapter 89C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for state officers and employees in the executive branch who are excluded from collective bargaining and belong to the same compensation plan as those officers and employees within collective bargaining unit (5):

SECTION 4. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part shall be allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state departments for expenditure for the purposes of this part.

PART III

SECTION 5. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is paid in whole or in part from federal, special, or other funds



1 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
2 from the respective funds.

3 SECTION 6. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
4 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2009, shall
5 lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
