A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The department shall expend the moneys from the state 2 parks special fund for the following purposes: 3 Permanent and temporary staff positions; (1)4 (2) Planning and development of state parks programs, 5 including the aina hoomalu state parks program; Construction, repairs, replacement, additions, and 6 (3) 7 extensions of state parks facilities; 8 (4)Operation and maintenance costs of state parks and state parks programs; and 9 10 (5) Administrative costs of the division of state parks. 11 (c) There is established within the state parks special 12 fund, a Diamond Head State Monument sub-account, into which 13 shall be deposited fifty-five per cent of all proceeds collected 14 from the admission fees charged at the Diamond Head State 15 The department shall expend the moneys from the Monument. 16 Diamond Head State Monument sub-account for repair, maintenance, 17 and operating costs incurred by the State in the management of 18 the Diamond Head State Monument. 19 There is established within the state parks special 20 fund, a Kokee state park and Waimea canyon state park 21 sub-account, into which per cent of all proceeds collected 22 from concessions, leases, and commissions, as well as other user

- 1 fees, charged at or for Kokee state park and Waimea canyon state
- 2 park, less any amounts due to the office of Hawaiian affairs,
- 3 shall be deposited. The department shall expend the moneys from

Establishes a sub-account under the state parks special fund into which a percentage of the proceeds collected from the various fees collected at the Kokee state park and Waimea canyon state park, less any amounts due to OHA, will be deposited and used to cover the cost of repair, maintenance, and operation at the Kokee state park and Waimea canyon state park.
