RELATING TO ELECTRIC AUTOMOBILES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of business, economic 2 development, and tourism shall develop an implementation plan to 3 increase electric, hybrid electric, and plug-in hybrid 4 automobile use in Hawaii. 5 (b) In creating the plan, the department of business, economic development, and tourism shall confer and consult with 6 7 the automobile industry, governmental agencies, and other 8 interested parties. 9 The plan shall have the following objectives: 10 By 2015, ten per cent of the new automobiles imported (1) 11 into the State shall be required to be powered by 12 electricity; and 13 (2) By 2025, twenty per cent of the new automobiles 14 imported into the State shall be required to be

- 4 (c) For purposes of this section:
- 5 "Electric automobile" shall mean an automobile that uses an
- 6 electric motor and motor controller instead of an internal
- 7 combustion engine.
- 8 "Hybrid electric automobile" shall mean an automobile that
- 9 combines a conventional propulsion system with an on-board
- 10 internal rechargeable energy storage system to achieve better
- 11 fuel economy than a conventional automobile.
- 12 "Plug-in hybrid automobile" shall mean a hybrid automobile
- 13 with batteries that are recharged by an external electric power
- 14 source.
- 15 SECTION 2. The department of business, economic
- 16 development, and tourism shall submit the implementation plan to
- 17 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
- 18 of the 2009 regular session.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
